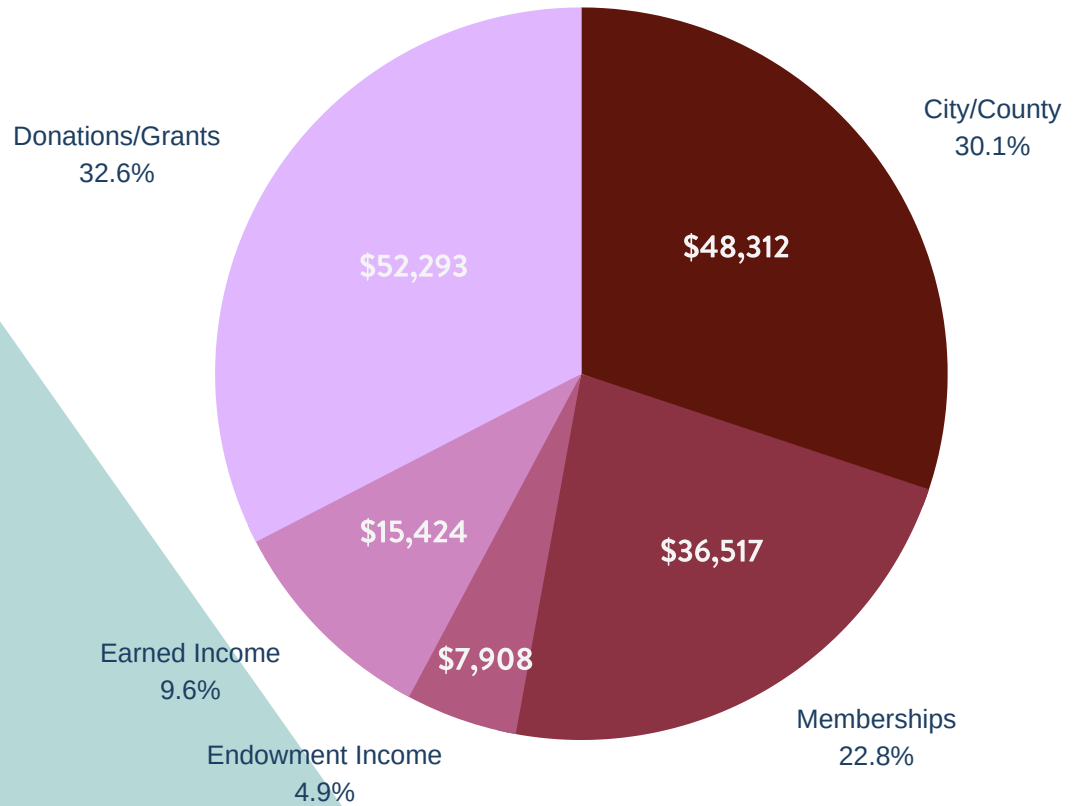

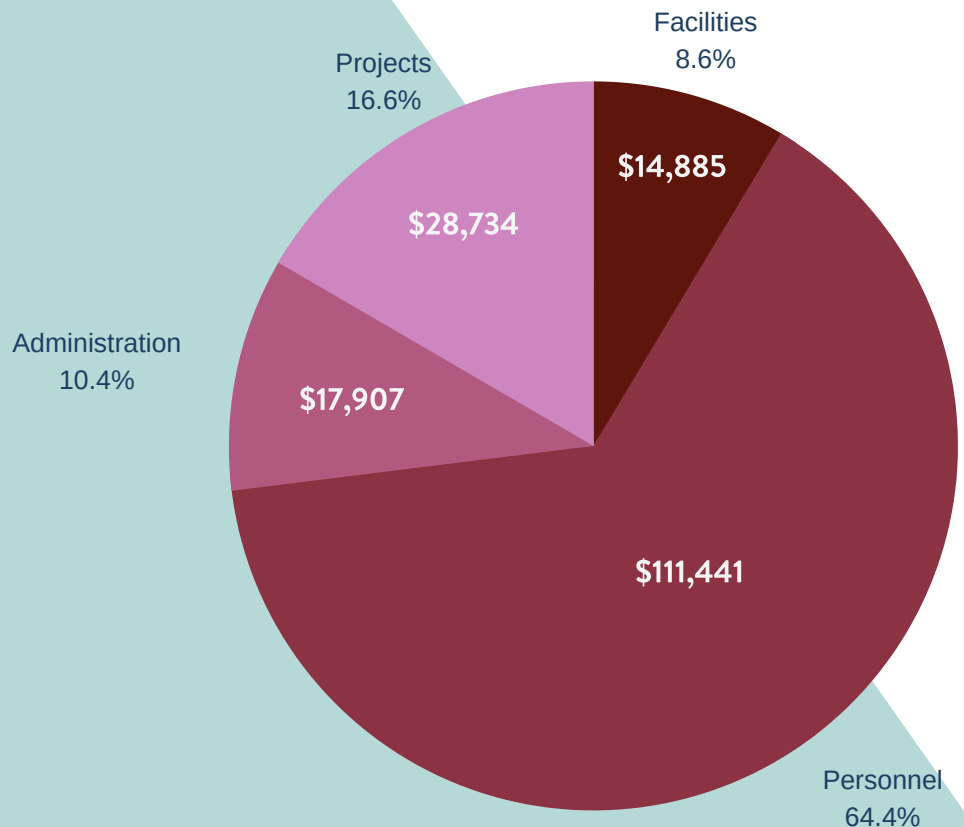

COLLECTIONS & EXHIBITS

- Completed work on a two-year State of Iowa Historical Resource Development Program grant received in 2017 to catalog and better store artifacts. During the project, volunteers cataloged over 2,000 objects. Each object was matched with its legal paperwork, assessed for condition, photographed, and entered into PastPerfect museum software.
- Launched PastPerfect Online to provide better public access to collections.
- Interesting objects received in 2019 included: Miss Ames dress and trophy, Harrison Barnes jersey, police uniforms, CyRide Moonlight Express signs, flapper dress.
- "Exploring Historic Ames: Unique Selections from the Farwell T. Brown Photographic Archive" was on display until early August. In late August, "Uncorked: The Spirited History of Alcohol in Ames" opened.
- The feature exhibit from a couple of years ago, "Ames Hi Aiming High Through the Years," was converted to a traveling exhibit, available for rental.



VOLUNTEERS



- Volunteers worked 5140.5 hours in 2019 - equivalent to 2.5 full-time employees! The current worth of a volunteer hour is estimated to be \$23.41 by Independent Sector. 2019 volunteer hours were worth \$119,407.50.
- Volunteer projects included: scanning phone books and photos, collections cataloging, greeting visitors at the front desk, creating finding aids for the archives, newspaper research, exhibit installation, serving on committees, and more.
- Three interns from Iowa State volunteered for the summer: Lucas Ruby (collections), Julia Martell (collections), and Lauren Jones (marketing and events).

PROGRAMS AND EVENTS

- Another successful lecture series took place March through June. Total attendance for the five lectures was 422.
 - In June, a cemetery walk featuring women from Ames history was held at the Municipal Cemetery. Beautiful weather and an engaging program brought a large crowd.
 - Hoggatt School was open each Sunday afternoon from June 9 through August 11. Programs included an 1860s tasting experience, schoolyard games, soap-making, and others. Hoggatt School had 274 summer visitors, plus ten groups of school children in the spring.
 - Staff and volunteers participated in many community events including ArtWalk, MusicWalk, Summerfest in Campustown, PrideFest, Octagon Art Festival, and Snow Magic.
 - The annual benefit dinner in August was attended by 139 people. Awards were given to Mary Atherly and the Buck Family. "Speakeasy" was the theme for the evening. The following day, the "Uncorked" exhibit opened at the museum. The opening event included 1920s mocktails, beer garden, Prohibition photo booth, and lots of fun.
 - Two Holocaust survivors visited Ames in 2019 - Celina Karp Biniacz in March and Michael Bornstein in September. Attendance at these talks totaled over 1,100.
