



2020 INCOME - \$178,087





EXHIBITS & COLLECTIONS

- Due to the pandemic, the museum was closed March 17 through October 15. We reopened with limited hours on October 16, and then moved to visits by appointment beginning November 14.
- "Uncorked: The Spirited History of Alcohol in Ames" was on display in the gallery.
- Lobby and window exhibit topics included: City Hall bombing anniversary, flappers, Billy Sunday, Resource Recovery Plant, Paul Martin, WOI, and old-fashioned Christmas.
- A traveling exhibit, "Power + Pluck: Remarkable Women of Story County," was on display in six communities, including in AHM's windows.
- Two virtual exhibits were launched in 2020, "Hometown Teams: How Sports Shaped Ames" and "Hoggatt School Tour." These 360-degree online experiences allow visitors to view exhibit panels, photos, and videos from home.
- Interesting objects received in 2020 included: Civil War letters and discharge paper, 1940s wedding dress and suit, Ames Pottery pieces, 1868 presidential campaign button, and Air Force uniforms.
- AHM's collections manager, Carly Hlubek, moved away in November. She accomplished a lot in her four years with the organization, and we're sad to see her go! We will be hiring for the position in early 2021.
- Work continued on object cataloging and archives finding aid projects. Additional objects were added to the online collections catalog, providing better public access to collections.
- AHM launched a contemporary collecting project to record current events, including the COVID-19 pandemic, the August 10 derecho, and Black Lives Matter marches held in Ames on May 30, June 18 and 24, and August 21 and 26. Donations documenting these events are still being accepted.



EVENTS & ENGAGEMENT

- During the pandemic, AHM increased online engagement through emails, social media, and digital resources. "Museum Mondays" weekly emails featured artifacts, stories, and videos from Ames history, along with links to digitized research resources. Engagement on AHM's Facebook, Instagram, and YouTube pages increased 327% compared to 2019 engagement.
- A special "Ames History at Home" section was developed on AHM's website. This includes links to online exhibits, research help, events, and history activities to do at home.
- Hundreds of Ames history resources are now available online - yearbooks, phone books, city directories, maps, books, and more! These are accessible through AHM's website.
- The 2020 Lecture Series was moved online, April through June. Total live attendance for the three lectures was 225, and the recordings have been watched on YouTube 622 times.
- In lieu of programming at Hoggatt School this summer, we released three new videos: "What's in Your Lunchbox?," "1860s Spelling Bee," and "How to Make Butter at Home." These are still available to watch on AHM's YouTube channel.
- AHM's annual benefit event became an online week of giving this year! The theme was "Feeling Groovy," with a focus on life and businesses in Ames in the 1960s. We engaged more than 14,700 people during the week through themed social media posts and emails. Awards were given to Nelson Electric Company, Carol Alexander Phillips, and Carole Jensen. The event netted more than \$10,000.
- The AHM Board of Directors made a commitment in 2020 to focus on diversity, equity, accessibility, and inclusion through more in-depth research, exhibits, and programs. As part of this initiative, a vinyl mural featuring people of color from Ames history will be installed on the museum building in early 2021.
